Their five character/dolls include [Wan Ling is a panda lover from China](#) (pictured left), [Lulu is an aspiring soccer star and co-host on a children's TV show in Kenya](#), [Zoe is a bohemian songwriter from New York](#), [Gia is a fashionista and budding designer from Italy](#) and [Pita is a medal-winning equestrian from Mexico](#). It's aimed for ages 6 and up- though the dolls are supposed to be 11 years old.

The facial features are beautiful. The 21 inch poseable dolls comes with a 144 page [book](#) and are made of phthalate-free vinyl with a torso that is 1/3 vinyl and 2/3 soft 100% cotton filled with polyester fill.
